### From the Pastor's Desk



*My dear parishioners,*

Today we begin the new liturgical year with the season of Advent. The liturgical year helps us to meditate on different aspects of the life of our Lord Jesus Christ and to draw inspirations on the way to live our Christian life, in the imitation of Christ. The word Advent derives from the Latin words: *Advenire*, which means to come; or *Adventus*, which means arrival. It is an important season in the life of the Church, which prepares us for the coming of the Messiah, the Savior of the world, our Lord Jesus Christ. As such, the season of Advent takes a double meaning. It becomes preparation for the Lord's coming at Christmas, when we commemorate the birth of the Lord Jesus in Bethlehem, but also preparation for the second coming of the Lord at the end of time. In the Gospel of this Sunday, the Lord tells us to be vigilant. He says, "*Be watchful! Be alert! You do not know when the time will come*" (Mark 13:33). The Lord speaks of the time of his return in glory, when he will come to judge the living and the dead. As people of faith and disciples of the Lord, we need to be prepared each and every day so as to be found worthy for the day of the Lord. We cannot be complacent and live according to the standards of the world, rather we should live by the teachings of the Lord, which are summarized by the commandment of love. To live by the teachings of the Lord makes us people of light who give witness to the world and impact the world by our good deeds. The Lord says that we should be alert and watchful, otherwise his coming may happen suddenly and find us sleeping. Let us take this opportunity that the season of Advent offers us to look into our lives, to change what needs to be changed through a genuine conversion, and so be ready for the coming of our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.



# 1<sup>er</sup> Dimanche de l'Avent – Année B

Chers frères et sœurs,

Nous avons commencé aujourd'hui la nouvelle année liturgique avec la saison d'Avent. L'année liturgique nous aide à méditer sur différents aspects de la vie de notre Seigneur Jésus Christ et nous inspirer sur la manière de vivre notre vie chrétienne en imitant le Christ. Le mot "Avent" vient des mots Latin comme "Advenire", qui signifie venir ou encore "Adventus" qui signifie "arrivée." La saison d'Avent est une saison importante dans la vie de l'Eglise, qui nous prépare pour la venue du Messie, le Sauveur du monde, notre Seigneur Jésus Christ. Comme telle, la saison de l'Avent prend une double signification. Ça devient préparation pour la venue du Christ à Noël, quand nous célébrons la naissance du Seigneur Jésus à Bethléhem, mais aussi préparation pour la seconde venue du Christ à la fin des temps. Dans l'évangile de ce Dimanche, le Seigneur nous invite à la vigilance. Il dit: "Prenez garde, restez éveillés : car vous ne savez pas quand ce sera le moment" (Marc 13:33). Le Seigneur parle du moment de sa venue dans la gloire, quand il viendra juger les vivants et les morts. En tant que peuple de foi et disciples du Seigneur, nous devons nous préparer chaque jour pour être dignes pour le jour du Seigneur. Nous ne pouvons pas être complaisants et vivre selon les normes de ce monde, plutôt nous devons vivre par les enseignements du Seigneur qui se résument par le commandement de l'amour. Mettre en pratique les enseignements du Christ fait de nous un peuple de lumière qui donne témoignage au monde et qui influence le monde par nos bonnes oeuvres. Le Seigneur nous dit d'être en alerte et vigilant, sinon sa venue nous surprendra et nous trouvera endormis.
